## SPECIAL WINTER 2018 SHUTTLE SCHEDULES

### HOLIDAY “EVES”

Effective for **Wednesday, November 21 (Thanksgiving Eve)**; normal schedule during the day, with the following changes for the evening:

**LOOP:** Last stop in the Navy Yard at Broad Street Gate will be at 6:08 p.m.

**EXPRESS:** Last stop in the Navy Yard at Broad Street Gate will be at 5:16 p.m. (run starts at 5:12 p.m. at League Island Blvd & Crescent Drive).

Effective for **Monday, December 24 (Christmas Eve) and Monday, December 31 (New Year’s Eve):**

**LOOP:** The first run will depart from NRG Station at 6:03 a.m. (no 5:38 a.m. shuttle). Last stop in the Navy Yard at Broad Street Gate will be at 6:08 p.m.

**EXPRESS:** There will be NO service to Center City. Shuttle runs as often as possible between 6:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. The Express will run its internal Navy Yard route, making all stops within the campus, then proceed to NRG Station on the SEPTA Broad Street Line on a continuous loop. There will be no set stop times as the shuttle will make its runs as quickly as possible. Riders can expect a shuttle approximately every 30 minutes at the top and bottom of the hour.

### HOLIDAYS

Effective for **Thursday November 22 (Thanksgiving Day), Tuesday, December 25 (Christmas Day), and Tuesday, January 1, 2019 (New Year’s Day).**

**EXPRESS & LOOP: NO SERVICE.**

### BLACK FRIDAY

Effective for **Friday November 23 (Day after Thanksgiving):**

**LOOP:** No change.

**EXPRESS A.M.:** Shuttles depart SEPTA Jefferson Station approximately every 30 minutes starting at 6:30 a.m. and ending at 10:00 a.m. (does not follow normal schedule). There will be no service between 10:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

**EXPRESS P.M.:** Shuttles depart League Island Blvd & Crescent Drive approximately every 30 minutes beginning at 2:30 p.m. with the last run to Center City at 5:00 p.m. (does not follow normal schedule).

### WINTER EMERGENCY

During the winter months, there is a high risk of major delays in service due to slow/stopped traffic on Route I-95 and in Center City. As implemented several times last year, this “Winter Emergency” shuttle plan will apply:

If we declare a “Winter Emergency,” we will state the timeframe via email, Twitter (@NavyYardPhila), and Facebook (/TheNavyYard). We will give as much advance notice as possible, but it may be implemented and effective immediately, depending on the timing of a snow/ice event.

**LOOP A.M.:** The first run will depart from NRG Station at 6:03 a.m. (no 5:38 a.m. shuttle).

**LOOP P.M.:** We do not anticipate any deviation from schedule unless the storm is so severe as to force us to end service early. If we must end service early, we will notify tenants via email and social media.

**EXPRESS A.M. & P.M.:** Shuttle runs as often as possible between 6:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. There will be NO service to Center City. The Express will run its internal Navy Yard route, making all stops within the campus, and then proceed to AT&T Station on a continuous loop. There will be no set stop times as the shuttle will make its runs as quickly as possible, but riders can expect a shuttle approximately every 15 minutes.



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
