



NAVY YARD SPECIAL SHUTTLE SCHEDULES (as of November 17, 2017)

HOLIDAY "EVES"

Effective for **Thanksgiving Eve - Wednesday, November 22rd**: There will be a normal schedule during the day, except for the following changes:

LOOP: Last stop in The Navy Yard at Broad Street Gates will be at **6:08 p.m.**

EXPRESS: The last stop in The Navy Yard at **Broad Street Gates** will be at **5:14 p.m.** (run starts at 5:10 P.M. at League Island Blvd & Crescent Drive).

As December 24th and December 31st are on Sunday this year, there is no change to the schedule for Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.

HOLIDAYS

Effective for **Thanksgiving - Thursday November 23th**, **Christmas - Monday, December 25th** and **New Year's Day - Monday, January 1st**:

EXPRESS & LOOP: NO SERVICE.

DAY AFTER HOLIDAYS

Effective for **Friday, November 24th only. December 26th and January 2nd are not affected.**

LOOP: No change.

EXPRESS A.M.: Shuttles depart Jefferson Station (formerly Market East) approximately *every 30 minutes* starting at **6:30 a.m. and ending at 11:30 a.m.** (does not follow normal schedule).

EXPRESS P.M.: Shuttles depart League Island Blvd & Crescent Drive approximately *every 30 minutes* beginning at 12:00 p.m. with the last run to Center City at **5:10 p.m.** (There is no 5:00 p.m., it leaves at 5:10)

WINTER EMERGENCY

During the winter months, there is a high risk of serious delays in service due to slow/stopped traffic on Route I-95 and in Center City. Therefore, if we declare a "**Winter Emergency**", we will state the timeframe, and it may be implemented in advance depending on the timing of a snow/ice event.

LOOP A.M.: The first run will depart from AT&T Station at **6:03 a.m.** (no 5:38 a.m. shuttle).

LOOP P.M.: We do not anticipate any deviation from schedule unless the storm is so severe as to force us to end service early. If we must end service early, we will notify tenants via email and social media.

EXPRESS A.M. & P.M.: Two (instead of four) Shuttles will run as often as possible between **6:00 a.m. to 6:00 pm.** **There will be NO service to Center City.** The Express will run its internal Navy Yard route, making all stops within the campus, and then proceed to AT&T Station on a continuous loop. There will be no set stop times as the shuttle will make its runs as quickly as possible, but riders can expect a shuttle approximately every 15 minutes.

Again, as with the Loop, if weather dictates that we have to end the shuttle service early, we will provide as much notice as possible.
